

## MISSIONARY AGREEMENT

An agreement between All Points Baptist Mission (APBM) and the missionary.

APBM agrees:

1. To serve as the funds handling agency representing the missionary, if, in the event the missionary's sending church is unable or unwilling to do so, and to receive and process funds designated to the missionary on a monthly schedule normally used by mission agencies. This will be done at no charge to the missionary.
2. To promote the ministry of the missionary in its general promotion; however, APBM assumes no obligation to solicit funds for the missionary or to contribute undesignated funds to the missionary.
3. To provide the missionary with a letter of Guarantee or similar document, only if his sending church cannot provide such. In which case APBM will require a Furlough Fund or other reserves to protect APBM in this financial responsibility.
4. To keep confidential the financial records of the missionary.
5. To not interfere with the leadership of the Holy Spirit in the missionary's conduct of his ministry. APBM's relationship with the missionary is clearly identified and limited by this agreement.

The Missionary agrees:

1. To uphold the standards of Christian ethics and morality as a representative of the Lord Jesus Christ, of his sending church, of All Points Baptist Mission and of supporting churches, and to avoid criticism of other missionaries associated with APBM.
2. To avoid debt in the name of APBM. Missionaries are encouraged to avoid all debt, following the scriptural admonition "Owe no man anything" Rom. 13:8. However, as a matter of policy, APBM only requires the missionary to agree: (a) not to incur any indebtedness in the name of or on behalf of APBM, either express or implied; and (b) not to acquire credit cards or credit accounts in the name of APBM.
3. To uphold the laws of the country to which he goes as a missionary as well as the laws of his homeland.
4. To the following procedure, if, in the opinion of APBM, it becomes necessary: or shall a question shall arise concerning the legal, moral, doctrinal, or financial integrity of the missionary, APBM shall ask for a meeting with the pastor and deacons of the Missionary's sending church. APBM will give to them, and only to them, any evidence it has to offer. The missionary is to be given sufficient notice to enable him to attend the meeting if he desires. If the offense goes unresolved and/or the missionary is not restored, or the situation comes to an otherwise unsatisfactory end,

APBM will withdraw its endorsement of the missionary, this agreement will be terminated, and the supporters so notified. APBM would then continue to handle funds until other arrangements can be made by the missionary.

Neither of the signing parties shall change the terms of this Agreement without the consent of the other.

Either of the signing parties may cancel this agreement at any time by certified letter to the other party.
