Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It has been a busy two months since our last prayer letter. We completed the advanced missionary training offered at Baptist Bible Translators Institute and graduated on May 12. To be honest I was somewhat hesitant initially about the program but I am so glad to have completed the course and would wholeheartedly recommend BBTI to anyone with an interest in missions or looking to serve as a missionary. It was nine months of intense training that we know has better equipped us to accomplish mission work. We are looking forward to applying what we have learned from BBTI in Greenland.

My oldest son Timothy got married on May 19 to Chole Nissley. We are excited he has found his perfect mate. It makes leaving him so much easier as he now has a family of his own. We are thrilled to see them start a new life and serve the Lord together. We are also leaving our oldest daughter Katelynn behind. Please pray for the Lord's leading in her life. We also covet your prayers for our three youngest children and the adjustments that lie ahead. We simply desire our children to serve the Lord wholeheartedly where ever they are. We were able to visit Cheryl's grandparents following the wedding. It was hard realizing this may be the last time seeing them but rest in the Lord's promises knowing we shall meet again in heaven.

Our container will arrive on June 22 which leaves us about 3 weeks to secure everything we will need for Greenland. We are currently in the "fun" process of sorting and repacking as our belongings have been in storage for the past few years. We have to go back through all those things and decide what we will take to Greenland. Not all things are practical or needed, but we don't want to overlook anything we might potentially need.

We have purchased our airline tickets and our scheduled departure is July 10. Please continue to pray that God would open the right doors for housing. We have a few specifics that we are requesting from the Lord in the matter of our housing, but honestly, we just want to be somewhere we can call home.

We only have 3 more scheduled meetings left of deputation. In the past 2 ½ years we have been in over 315 different churches and driven over 120,000 miles. God has exceeded our expectations. He has met every need and kept us safe. We have made memories and friends that we will cherish for a lifetime. We believe God has allowed us to raise our necessary support but also realize He truly knows what we need. We are grateful for the generosity of God's people that have given, prayed, and encouraged us to continue forward in taking the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to the people of Greenland. In just a few more weeks this will become a reality. Thank you for your support in prayers and finances. May the Lord richly bless you.
